- DUTIES:** Responsible for providing comprehensive health maintenance, preventive and primary medical care and treatment for adult inmates in a county corrections facility and for juveniles in both a county juvenile corrections facility and a county residential shelter facility, under the supervision of a local physician. Also provides nursing care to inmates who have mental disorders during their confinement.

EXPERIENCE:** Bachelor of Science degree in Nursing from an accredited school of nursing with one year of nursing experience, preferably in a public health position; or an Associate degree in Nursing from an accredited school of nursing with three years of nursing experience.

KNOWLEDGE:** Knowledge of the principles, practices, methods and procedures of nursing as applied to primary care, considerable knowledge of the uses and effects of medications, immunizations provided in a primary care clinic; considerable knowledge of issues related to alcohol and drug abuse and psychopathology. Knowledge of medical record keeping practices. Ability to work independently; ability to courteously meet and deal with patients; maintaining effective working relationships with staff, supervisors, physicians, other agencies and the public; ability to act in a professional manner and to understand and commit to a professional code of ethics; ability to maintain confidentiality. Ability to deal with sensitive issues, such as HIV testing and counseling, pregnancy testing and counseling. Physical capability to interact with others and perform mobility requirements of the position.

CERTIFICATES:** Must possess a valid license to practice in the State of Oregon as a Registered Professional Nurse, in accordance with ORS 678.010 to 678.360 at the time of appointment. Must possess a valid Oregon motor vehicle license with good driving record, or ability to obtain within 30 days date of hire.
- SPECIAL TESTING:** Must be available to work any shift. Must be a resident of Lincoln County within 30 days of hire date. Employment is contingent upon the successful completion of a criminal history check and driver's license check. Some positions may be dependent upon successful completion of a drug test.
