investigations, marine, forest, animal control enforcement, civil service, bicycle patrol and SWAT.



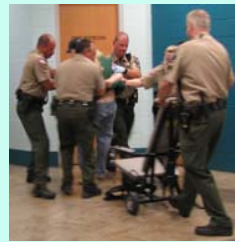
Deputy Compensation & Benefits (2009 figures)

Salary Range: \$3534 - \$4591 monthly DOQ

The successful candidate will be eligible for:

- Membership in the Oregon Public Employees Retirement System (PERS).*
- Fully paid health, vision, and dental plans for the family (including orthodontia).*
- Certification pay (2% for Intermediate and 4% for Advanced)*
- 24 hours bonus vacation time added yearly.*
- Shift overtime.*
- Longevity pay of 1% after ten years.*
- Vacation time at the rate of eight hours per month thru five years of employment increasing two hours per month every five years thereafter.*
- Furnished uniforms, equipment and leather gear with a monthly uniform cleaning allowance of \$50.00.*
- Compensation for call-back to duty is paid at a minimum of three hours at time and one-half.*
- Deputies participate in the Lincoln County Deputies' Association.*
- 457 deferred compensation plan available.*
